#### **ELIGIBILITY/LIMITATIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIP AWARD**

The following are the eligibility requirements:

- 1. Applicant must be a senior graduating from a high school or homeschool program during the 2023-2024 school year.
- 2. Applicant must be a dependent with a current identification and privilege card.
- 3. The sponsor of the applicant must meet ONE of the following eligibility requirements:
  - Active-duty U.S. Military member currently assigned in Hawaii
  - Active-duty U.S. Military member on a remote assignment from Hawaii
  - Retired U.S. Military member residing in Hawaii
  - Full-time Hawaii National Guard member\*\*
  - Full-time U.S. Military Reserve member residing in Hawaii\*\*
  - Deceased U.S. Military member with applicant residing in Hawaii \*\*Please contact hosescholarship@gmail.com to verify eligibility

The following applicants are **NOT** eligible for an award:

- 1. Anyone who has previously been selected for an HOSC scholarship award
- 2. Anyone on a full scholarship (includes full payment of tuition, fees, and room & board)
- 3. Selection committee members and family members of selection committee members
- 4. Scholarship committee members and family members of scholarship committee members

#### TOTAL SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED

The HOSC Governing Board will award scholarships and approve the total number of scholarships as well as the total amount awarded per scholarship.

## **SELECTION COMMITTEE**

Scholarship applications shall be reviewed by the HOSC Scholarship Committee and scored by independent judges unaffiliated with the HOSC Governing Board and Advisors. Decisions of the Selection Committee are final.

#### AWARD RECIPIENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. The scholarship must be used by the recipient at an accredited college, university, or technical/vocational school during the fall semester of 2024 and/or spring semester of 2025. In addition, scholarships may be used at a school pending accreditation by an organization approved by the US Department of Education.
- 2. The scholarship may be used for the payment of tuition, fees, books, and/or room and board charged by the Finance or Business Office of the school.
- 3. Recipients must submit to the Scholarship Coordinator a signed copy of the 2024 Use of Awards Agreement & Statement of Intent no later than September 30, 2024. Use of Awards Agreements & Statement of Intent forms will be given to each recipient following the announcement of winners.
- 4. Verification of enrollment must be sent to the Scholarship Coordinator and received by

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September 30, 2024, for scholarships used during the Fall semester and January 31, 2024, for scholarships used during the Winter/Spring semester. Verification of Enrollment options will be explained in your Use of Awards Agreement. Any fees associated with verifying enrollment are the responsibility of the recipient.

- 5. The HOSC Welfare Treasurer shall issue a check in the full amount of the scholarship payable to the educational institution that has verified the recipient's enrollment. Checks will not be issued directly to the recipient.
- 6. Failure to meet the above deadlines will result in the recipient's scholarship being forfeited.
